



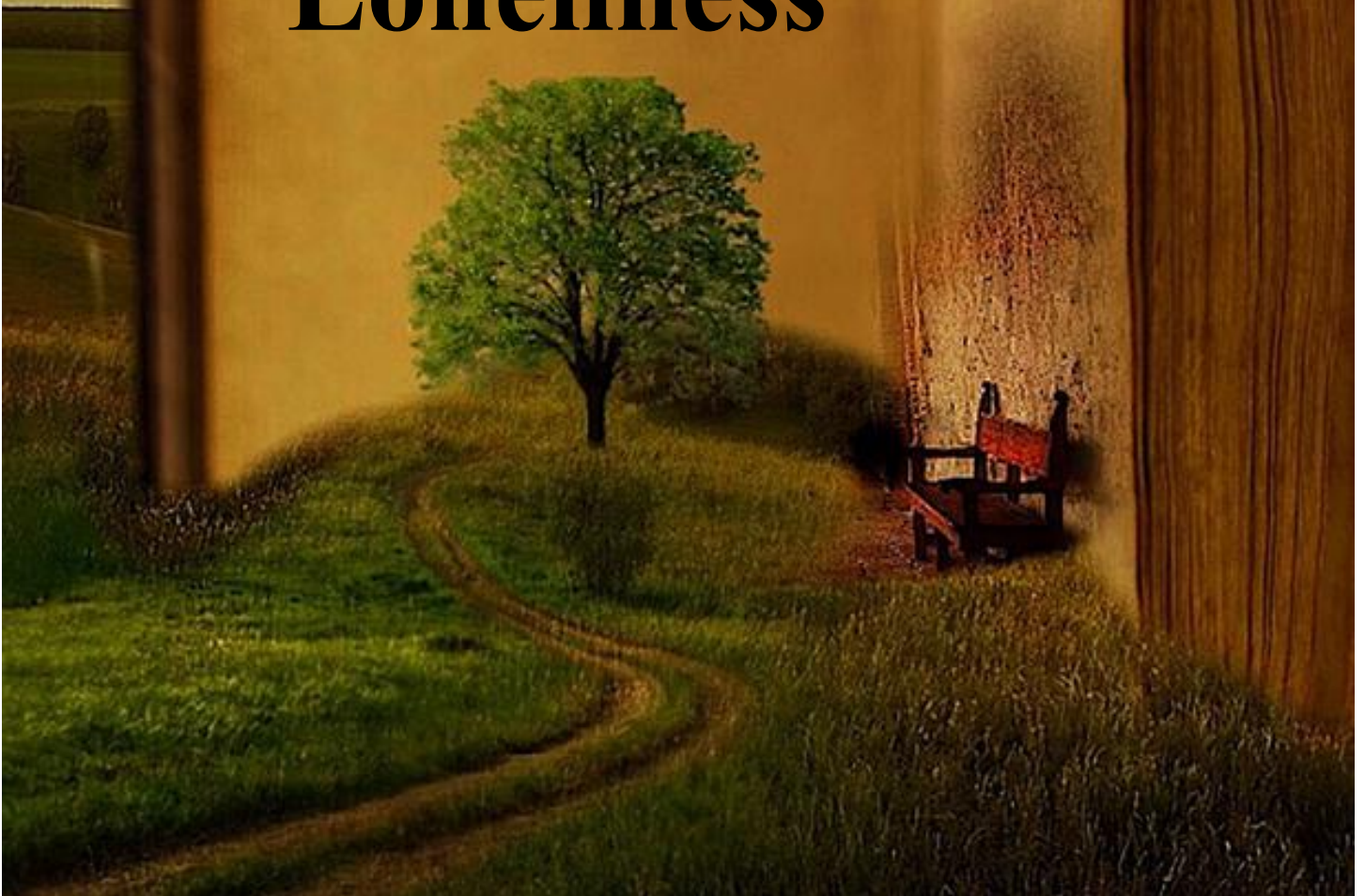

People sometimes can be mean and can hurt us, just as we can do to others; however, we can always depend upon God's love and faithfulness to us. Even when it seems like we are all alone in life, we can always talk with God, knowing that He cares and understands. Do you know God—or are you a stranger to Him?

While we each have a natural need and desire for friends and to be accepted, often people turn away from God in order to have friends in this life—friends who do not follow God. That must hurt God when we reject Him and His love in order to do our own thing or to try to be more popular in this world. Often, those who follow God the most closely seem to be rejected the most by those of the world. Is it more important to you to be accepted by God or to be accepted by people?

There are many Biblical examples of people who were rejected by many people and who seemed all alone, yet they found comfort in God: Moses, Daniel, Jeremiah, Elijah, the apostle Paul—and even Jesus Himself. Does it comfort you to know that no matter how alone you feel, Jesus is there to listen and help you and be your friend?

Sometimes people who are Christians, but have stopped looking to God, try to fill their loneliness on their own, and end up in wrong or harmful relationships—either with friends, with dating, or even in marriage. How important is it to be content to wait upon God's time and to be certain that our relationships please Him?

There are times when we need to and want to be alone, but no one likes to be lonely. Do you make sure that you take time to be alone with God—free from distractions, and seeking Him?
